Open Educational Resources are teaching and learning materials that you may freely use and reuse, without charge. OER often have a Creative Commons license that state specifically how the material may be used, reused, adapted, and shared


Benefits of OER





OER are educational materials that are offered freely and under the open license to use, to improve, to re-mix and to distribute.

Creative Commons licences

A CC license is used when an author wants to give other people the right to share, use, and build upon a work that he or she has created. CC provides an author flexibility and protects the people who use or redistribute an author's work from concerns of copyright infringement as long as they abide by the conditions that are specified in the license by which the author distributes the work.

Open texbook collections

Open Textbook Library contains real, complete textbooks licensed so teachers and students can freely use, adapt, and distribute the material. Open textbooks can be downloaded for no cost, or printed inexpensively.

Future Learn is online learning course. It offers materials on Business & Management, Health & Psychology, Te-&coding, Teaching.


Open edX is the open source platform which includes educational materials.
