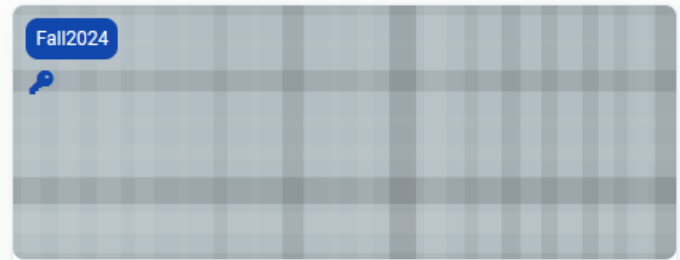

# Turnitin User Agreement

- When you upload an assignment for the first time on the e-Course, you need to accept the **Turnitin User agreement**.

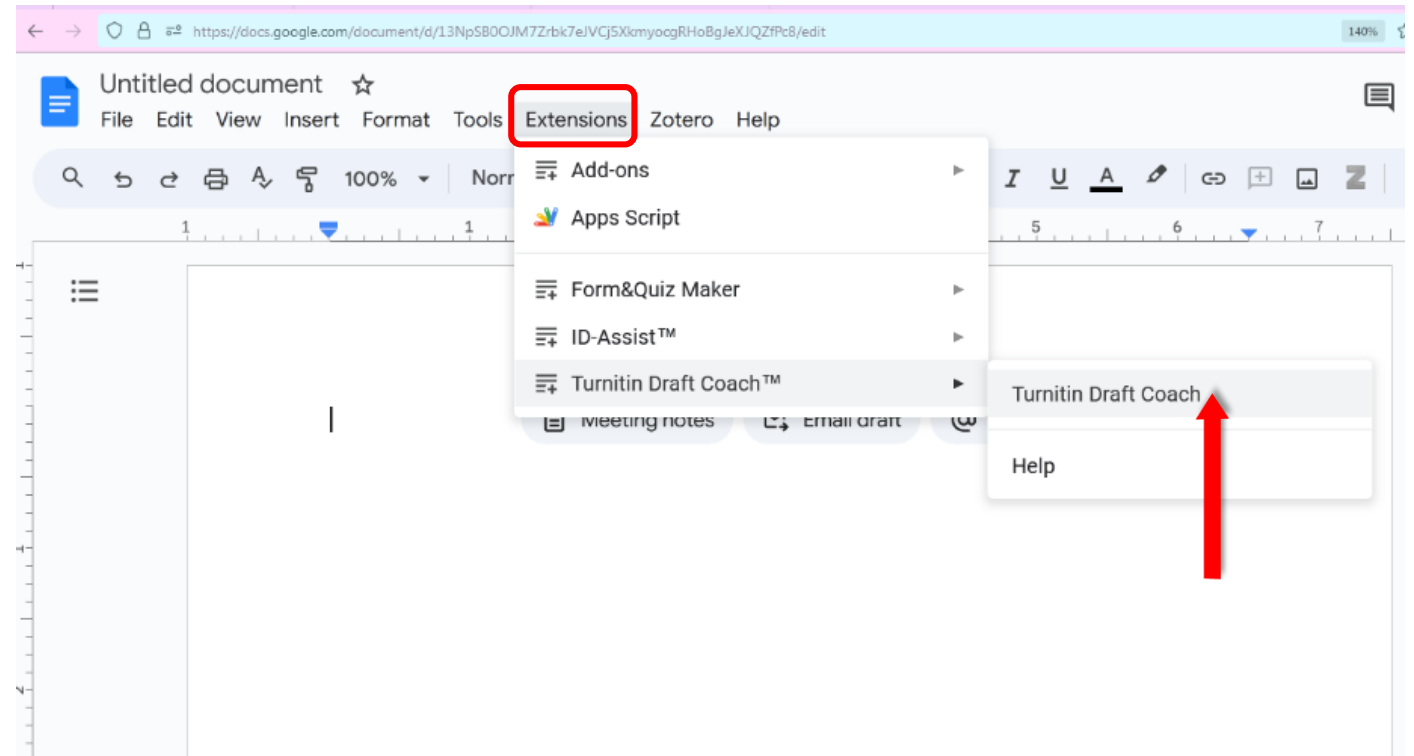
